Adult Staff Agreement

Etowah District welcomes and appreciates the help that you have volunteered to give us this year. We feel that a thorough understanding of Camp policies and staff operations is necessary in order to have a happy and rewarding Day Camp experience. Our purpose is for this day camp to operate smoothly and efficiently, and we want to make you aware of Camp rules and policies.

Staff members, in many respects, act in lieu of parents. The example the staff members set for these Scouts influence them positively or negatively, as the case may be. We want you to set the best example possible through personal neatness, language, manners, and any other conduct that could influence the Scouts. We request that you display a positive attitude, adhere to camp dress codes, and be conscious of the language that you use around the day campers.

1. You should use the principles you have learned in Scouting when dealing with the Scouts individually or as a group. Use the following guidelines in this area, as the Scout Oath, Scout Law, Cub Scout Motto, and the Outdoor Code encompass the basic ideals of Scouting:

- 2. Dress for Day Camp will be the camp T-Shirt, closed toe shoes, and either uniform shorts or shorts of comparable length. Any questions about dress code should be directed to the Camp Director.
- 3. There should be no swearing or inappropriate language.
- 4. We prefer that you do not smoke, but if you choose to smoke, you should only smoke in the designated areas located in the BBQ shelter behind the dining hall. We don't want you to be uncomfortable, but we want to make sure that we do not encourage smoking with our youth.

The duties and responsibilities of each Staff member will be given prior to the first day of camp, as well as assistance and information needed to carry out those assigned duties. However, circumstances may arise where the Camp Director may ask for additional assistance to benefit the overall Day Camp. Our primary goal is a quality program for our Scouts.

The Camp Director reserves the right to cancel all or part of this agreement under the following conditions:

- a. In the event of unsatisfactory performance.
- b. For personal conduct not in accord with Scouting principles.
- c. If camp attendance makes it necessary to curtail all or part of Day Camp.
- d. For any reason beyond the control of the Camp Director that necessitates the closing of the camp.

If you have any questions or reservations about anything that has been listed in this agreement, you should review this matter with the Camp Director before signing this agreement.
