National BSA requires all merit badge counselors to be registered, youth protection trained, and have a background check just like all adults in the organization whether-or-not they are a part of a scouting unit.

To become a merit badge counselor:

- 1.Fill out an Adult Application completely including ssn and background check disclosure (https://filestore.scouting.org/filestore/pdf/524-501.pdf)
- 2.Fill out a Merit Badge Counselor Information form (https://filestore.scouting.org/filestore/pdf/34405.pdf)
- 3.Take the Youth Protection Training at my.scouting.org Print a copy of the completion certificate to turn in with your other paperwork.
