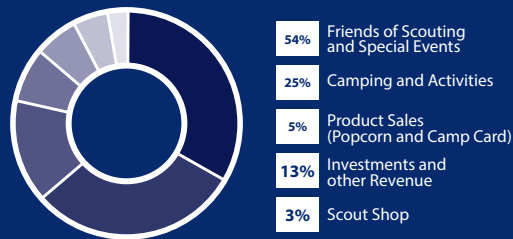


Council Highlights & Accomplishments

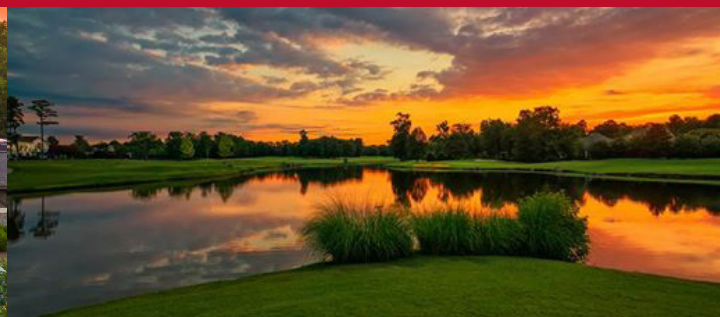
