Jr. Staff: Jr. Staff are youth ages 14-17. (Ages younger than 14 require unit leader or Scoutmaster Approval. Older than 17 only if Venturing Crew) Jr. Staff will assist in all camp duties and help fill in where as needed. Jr. Staffers are still youth and are expected to maintain the Buddy System, as well as, they are not to be with anything less than 2 Deep Leadership. Also, Youth Staffers are to never be left alone with campers. Jr. Staff works under the direction of the SPL and the ASPL's in areas they are assigned to assist. They may be asked to cover additional areas or change areas as needed.
