Please Note - Only registered MCC scouts may attend this year due to space limitation.

Activities: Cub Scouts will have the chance to experience all the fun of Steampunk while learning about the nuts and bolts of how things work. You will attend four 1-hour stations in the morning or afternoon. Activities include: Battle Airship using the Victorian Internet (morse code), Steampunk wares (Victorian themed hat or mask), Steampunk Geoboards, Bristle Bots, plus BB, Archery or Climbing.

Registration: Each Pack must submit a <u>registration form</u> listing all scouts and adults attending. Along with <u>completed A/B BSA medical forms</u> (don't forget Tetanus date!) and <u>signed Covid-Waiver</u> for each scout and adult attending.

** Please do not attend if you have temperature over 100 degrees. Please do not attend if you have Covid-19 or have come in contact with someone who has it in the 14 days prior to camp. Please let your Pack Coordinator know if this affects your attendance to this event. **

Pack Coordinators: Each Pack must supply a Pack Coordinator, who is a registered adult with their unit and be at least <u>Youth Protection Trained</u>. The Pack Coordinator must be available to help on Staff during the session they are attending.

Check-In: Every adult and scout must have temperature taken as you enter parking lot at front of camp. Please wait at car until appropriate check in time. Then during check in time, you may proceed to tables outside of Belk Welcome Center to finish the process. Please wait in CubORee field area until announcement time at flagpole.

Camping: Unlike years past, this event has been approved to be a day event only. No camping this year.

Gear: Ms. Angela's 7 Essential for CubORee 2021

- 2. Filled Water Bottle
- Simple Personal First Aid Kit/ Personal Hand sanitizer/ Mask
- 4. Snack (no meals for participants)

- 5. Sun/Raingear (hat/sunscreen/poncho)

 (<u>Adults & Scouts</u>- sneakers or hiking shoes only!)
- 7. An open mind and happy attitude that we are having camp!

Uniform: Class B- Pack t-shirt (if available); Must wear closed toe shoes (sneakers or hiking shoes); Flip flops and sandals are not allowed at camp for both adults and scouts.
